






Year 5 Camp

Welcome back to term 2 everyone. We hope that all PPS families had an enjoyable term break and have returned to school and its routines feeling refreshed and ready for a new term.

With many of the COVID restrictions having been lifted, the P&C had a much better start to the new school year than last year. We have benefited from and enjoyed many new faces on the Committee and in attendance at meetings. It has been terrific to see this increase in engagement and enjoy a return to face-to-face meetings. Despite being able to meet in person, following the 'COVID experience' we trialled our first simultaneous in-person and zoom meeting at our last rendezvous. Whilst there is room for improvement, it was very successful and allowed 10 parents to attend our meeting who otherwise would not have been able to do so. Our intention is to continue to hold meetings in this manner.

At our last meeting on 10 March in addition to the updates from our various Subcommittees we had a great discussion about school sport, especially the inter-school competition known as 'PSSA'. This agenda item followed various requests to the P&C regarding the desire of many parents to be more engaged with their children's school sport participation. Following the discussion, it was concluded that it would be highly beneficial for a parent representative to take on a new role of **"Sport & Swimming Liaison"**. The P&C Committee is now looking for a volunteer to take on this new role. It is envisaged that this representative would act as a conduit of information between the school and parents for all matters sport and swimming. As a new role, it would take shape over time. Ideally this parent volunteer would have children who actively participate in sport both in and out of the school and regularly checks Facebook (where many such questions are asked). Additionally, given that most of the sporting liaison matters concerns PSSA (inter-school sport) it would be beneficial to have children in grades 3 to 6. Since our last meeting we have applied for and been successful in obtaining the Bendigo Bank's community "**Double the impact Campaign**" **grant.** This initiative supports projects within the community whereby Bendigo Bank generously matches each dollar raised by an organisation with a dollar's donation from the bank. In consultation with the school, it was concluded that the best project to meet the application's criteria would be the installation of lighting along the Crown Road top gate entrance. This will dramatically improve the safety of PPS families and other community members who use school facilities after dark, such as external extra-curricular activities (karate, dance, drama), late band rehearsals in the winter months, P&C meetings and out of school hours activities in the hall for parents and staff training. Many thanks to Committee member Sally Davie for driving the application process and to Kate Walther for her assistance with the written application. Just before the term break, the P&C was able to hold its first "event" in over a year, being the visit of the **Easter Bunny** to the school. 
